1. INTRODUCTION

This document is part of the "Privacy Policy" of DPS, which is also composed of the notice published on the website www.easyre.it (hereinafter, the "Site"), which can be consulted HERE, and is prepared in compliance with the "Cookies and Other Tracking Tools Guidelines" of the Italian Data Protection Authority dated June 10, 2021, published in G. U. No. 163 on July 9, 2021, as well as in accordance with Regulation (EU) No. 2016/679, Directive 2002/58/EC, as amended, as transposed into national law in Article 122 of Legislative Decree No. 196 of June 30, 2003.

2. WHAT ARE COOKIES

Cookies are small text strings that the sites visited send to the user's terminal (usually to the browser used by the user) where they are stored and then retransmitted to the same sites on the next visit of the same user. Users who view the Site will see minimal amounts of information inserted into the devices in use (whether computers or mobile devices), in small text files called precisely "cookies", saved in the directories used by the user's web browser, for varying periods of time depending on the need.

3. TYPES OF COOKIES: GENERAL

First-party cookies are set by the site, whose address appears in the URL window.

Third-party cookies are set and managed by a site other than the one on which the user is browsing but linked to it for the management of particular types of content or services.

DPS has no direct access to and control over the cookies, web beacons and other tracking technologies used on third party websites that you may access from the Site, therefore, it expressly disclaims any responsibility with respect to such third party websites and their cookies. You are encouraged to read the privacy policy of third-party websites accessed through the Site to understand the conditions applicable to the processing of personal data on such websites.

4. TYPES OF COOKIES: DURATION

Session cookies are stored temporarily and are deleted, normally within 1 hour, when the user closes the browser window.

Domain cookies are intended to recognize the registered user when they return to the site once personal credentials have been authenticated. These cookies are similar to session cookies, since user and password are never automatically stored by the site after a user exits, and it is necessary to enter them each time one wants to access the site.

Persistent cookies are stored on the user's device between browser sessions, allowing the user's preferences or actions on the site to be remembered. Such cookies can be used for a

variety of purposes, such as to remember preferences and choices made when using the site.

5. COOKIE TYPES: FUNCTIONALITY

There are different types of cookies operating on the Site - with specific functions - which may belong to one or more of the following categories.

Technical Cookies.

Technical cookies are those that allow the storage of previous actions or to save the user's session or to perform other activities strictly necessary for the operation of a site. The use of such cookies does not require consent from the data subject.

Otherwise, "functionality" cookies allow the site to remember the user's choices in order to provide the user with more personalized and optimized navigation. Functional cookies are not essential to the operation of the site, but they improve its quality and browsing experience; if you do not accept them, the performance and functionality of the site may not be optimal and access to its content may be limited.

Analytical cookies

These are the cookies used to collect and analyze information that helps to understand how users interact with the site, providing for example:

- statistical information about access and visits to the website related to the last page visited;
- the number of sections and pages visited and the number of visitors;
- statistical information about the time spent on the site by the average user.

This information could be associated with user details such as IP address, domain or browser; however, when analyzed for the sole purpose of obtaining anonymous statistical information on site usage, the cookies that collect it can be assimilated to technical cookies.

For this reason, this type of cookie, which is not profiling, does not require the collection of consent from the data subject, even when used in aggregate form, as is the case, for example, when using Google reCaptcha or Google Analytics.

The former is an anti-spam service, while the latter is a web traffic analysis service, both provided by Google Inc.

As for Google reCaptcha, the third party (Google Inc.) may use cookies to contextualize or personalize ads in its advertising network, while Google Analytics makes use of cookies to collect and analyze, in aggregate form, information about users' browsing. The information generated by the cookie about your use of the site (including your IP address) is transmitted to and stored on Google's servers. Neither the site nor Google associates the user's IP address with any other data in their possession to directly identify the user. Profiling cookies

Profiling cookies are used to collect data and information regarding users' browsing (e.g. pages visited, actions taken, products purchased, demographic data) in order to provide

them with targeted and personalized advertisements based on their experience. Disabling, deleting or blocking these cookies prevents the collection of this kind of information and, consequently, the publication of these kinds of advertisements. Other, non-personalized types of advertisements might still appear, but they would not be related to previous use of the site. The Site does not make use of so-called "profiling" first-party cookies, but only so-called "third-party" cookies (aimed at receiving on your device, in the course of browsing a site, cookies sent from different sites or web servers).

Third-party cookies

This type of cookie integrates features and services developed by third parties within the pages of the site such as icons and preferences expressed in social networks, software to generate maps, the ability to access video streaming services and CDN networks or other additional services.

These cookies are sent from third-party domains and partner sites that offer their functionality between the pages of the Site. If you have an account or use the services of such parties on other websites, they may be able to know that you have visited the Site.

You should also keep in mind that such external parties, over which DPS cannot exercise any control, may intercept some of your personal data while you are browsing even outside the Site, due to the information stored in cookies to which you have consented to use. The use of data collected by these external operators via cookies is subject to their respective privacy policies. For detailed information on this, please consult the privacy policies of the services referred to as third-party cookies.

Social buttons plugin e widget

There are special "buttons" (called "social buttons/widgets") on the Site that depict the icons of social networks or other services (e.g., YouTube). These buttons allow users who are browsing the Site to interact with a "click" directly with the social networks depicted therein. In this case, the social network acquires data related to the user's visit, while DPS will not share any browsing information or user data acquired through its Site with the social networks accessed through the social buttons/widgets.

"Sharing" (or social network) cookies are necessary to allow users to interact with sites through their social accounts and are used, for example, to express an appreciation and share it with relevant social contacts.

The most common use is for the purpose of sharing social network content. The presence of plugins involves the transmission of cookies to and from all sites operated by third parties. The management of information collected by "third parties" is governed by the relevant disclosures to which please refer. 6. DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF THE COOKIES ADOPTED ON THE SITE

For better comprehension and maximum transparency, the characteristics of the cookies adopted on the Site are highlighted below:

7. THE COOKIE BANNER – INFORMATION ON USE

As imposed by the Provision "Identification of the simplified procedures for information and acquisition of consent for the use of cookies" of May 8, 2014, supplemented by the "Guidelines cookies and other tracking tools" of the Guarantor for the Protection of Personal Data of June 10, 2021, when provided, it is necessary for the user to express his consent to the use of cookies.

The user's consent is collected during their first access to the Site, through a banner that indicates certain mandatory information regarding the cookies used by the same. By continuing the use, closing the information band, the user declares that he/she accepts the use of technical cookies only. By clicking on the "Accept" button the user declares, instead, to accept the use of all cookies or other identifiers, while by clicking on the "See preferences" button the user will have the possibility to disable or deny consent to the use of any cookie, selecting, in an analytical way, the functionalities, the subjects (so-called third parties) and the cookies, grouped by homogeneous categories, to the use of which the user intends to consent.

The user will always have the possibility to remove such cookies at any time through the methods highlighted below.

8. HOW TO INSTALL OR REMOVE COOKIES FROM YOUR TERMINAL

You can decide which cookies to accept through the settings of the browser you use to browse. The default settings of most browsers are to accept cookies, but you can change these settings by intervening in your browser configuration. There are also various types of software that can act on cookies, such as web services or browser add-ons. The "Help" or "Help" section of the browser you use to browse contains all the information for enabling or blocking cookies; however, direct links for managing cookies on the most commonly used browsers are provided below:

9. EFFECTS OF DEACTIVATING COOKIES

Should you decide to deactivate cookies, you should consider their characteristics, to avoid incurring unwelcome changes while browsing the Site. In particular, the deactivation of technical cookies may prevent the use of certain features of the Site.

Disabling third-party cookies, on the other hand, does not normally affect the use of the Site. It could, however, result in the loss of specific functionality (e.g. sharing tools on social networks), the ability to analyze browsing data by the owner/operator, and/or the inability to track users in order to provide them with customized advertising content in line with their experience on the Website.
